IN RE: Collection of fines and costs by Sheriffs upon  
Agreement Between Clerk and Sheriff

1. In any county in the circuit, the Clerk of the Circuit Court and the Sheriff thereof may enter into an agreement whereby the Sheriff may continue, until further order, to receive and collect fines, costs and bond estreatures which may be assessed or adjudged in the courts of the county to the same extent as was done prior to January 2, 1973. The security and accounting of such collections and their proper disposition shall be initially the responsibility of the Sheriff and shall continue until they shall be accounted for and delivered to the Clerk or shall otherwise be disbursed in accord with law.

2. It is the intent of this Order to facilitate the transition consequent upon the implementation of Const. Art. V as amended, and statutes and rules enacted and promulgated pursuant thereto, and to reduce administrative procedures as may be practical and feasible to do so.

3. Copies hereof shall be furnished to each Clerk and Sheriff of the circuit and the Clerk shall record it in the public records of the county.
