ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO.

RE: Fines for Violation of Parking Regulations

- 1. It is declared that so-called fines for violations of parking regulations of a municipality or other agency are deemed to be <u>administrative penalties</u> rather than judicial fines, unless a warrant has been issued and filed in the County Court.
- 2. The collection of such administrative penalties is a function of the municipality or other agency which promulgates same, and not of the Clerk of the Circuit Court.
- 3. When a warrant has been issued and filed in the County Court the alleged violation is then a judicial matter and any fines or other penalties imposed therein by the County Court Judge shall be processed as in any other case in that Court.
