IN RE: Former Employees of County Judges' Offices

- 1. In any county of this circuit, the Clerk of the Circuit Court is authorized and empowered to employ personnel who were former employees of the County Judge's office and who were so employed on December 31, 1972. Any Clerk of this Circuit who in his judgment deems it expedient and appropriate to so employ said personnel aforementioned shall not be in violation of Section 116.111(2)(a),F.S., even though relationship may exist between the Clerk and an employee so employed.
- 2. It is the intent of this Order to facilitate the transition consequent upon the implementation of Const. Art. V as amended, and statutes and rules enacted and promulgated pursuant thereto, and to reduce administrative procedures as may be practical and feasible to do so.
- 3. Copies hereof shall be furnished to each Clerk of the Circuit Court and the Clerk shall record it in the public records of the county.
