ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 8

IN RE: Use of Funds Budgeted for the Office of County Judge
of any County of this Circuit to Defray Expenses of
the County Court.

1. All funds remaining in the County budget of any County
of this Circuit on December 31, 1972, allocated for the operation
of the Office of County Judge shall be disbursed to the Clerk
of the Circuit Court in equal monthly increments during the
period January 1, 1973, ending September 30, 1973, to be used
by the Clerk of the Circuit Court, in the discharge of additional
responsibilities of the Clerk as Clerk of the County Court.

2. It is the intent of this Order to facilitate the
transition consequent upon the implementation of Const. Art. V
as amended, and statutes and rules enacted and promulgated
pursuant thereto, and to reduce administrative procedures as may
be practical and feasible to do so.

3. Copies hereof shall be furnished to the Clerk and
the Judge of the County Court of all Counties of the Circuit
and the Clerk of each County shall record this Order in the
public records of the said County.
