IN RE: JURY SELECTION

ORDER TO RE-SELECT 1973 JURY LISTS

Pursuant to letter of instructions to be dated July 11, 1973, from the Honorable Vassar B. Carlton, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Florida, and read to the undersigned by telephone this date, clarifying current requirements of law concerning inclusion of individuals between the ages of eighteen (18) and twenty-one (21) years of age on grand and petit jury panels, the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of County, Florida is hereby requested, directed and ordered to forthwith dispose of currently existing lists of jurors in said county and to select a new list of jurors from the male and female population thereof of the age of eighteen (18) years and over and having the other constitutional and statutory qualifications for jurors in this State and to do any and all other things necessary and lawful to effectuate this Order. It is further


ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court promptly notify the undersigned when said new lists have been completed and all other things necessary have been accomplished to enable the drawing of venires for grand and petit juries therefrom. It is further

ORDERED that any presently existing grand jury in and for County be and is hereby discharged. It is further

ORDERED that all presently existing panels of petit juries in both County and Circuit Court be and are hereby discharged.
