ORDER APPOINTING CANVASSING BOARD MEMBER

The undersigned having been made aware that the Honorable
W D Wilson, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Taylor County
Martin L. Black, County Judge of Hamilton County, is a candidate
and therefore a member of the County election canvassing board pursuant to
the provisions of Florida Statutes 102.14(1), is himself a candidate
who has opposition in the election being canvassed on this September
12, 1978, and it having been brought to the/undersigned that the
person herein appointed has agreed to serve if appointed, it is
accordingly, *pursuant to provisions of FS 102.14(1)(b),*

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that HARRY T. REID, JR., a quali-
fied elector of Hamilton County who is not a candidate with oppo-
sition in the election being canvassed and who also is not an act-
ive participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with
opposition in the election being canvassed, be and is hereby ap-
pointed as a member of the Canvassing Board of Hamilton County,
Florida, to canvass the returns of the primary election being held
on this September 12, 1978.
