AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2014-001

RE: IMPANELMENT OF THE GRAND JURY

WHEREAS, it is the duty and responsibility of the Circuit Judges in the Third Judicial Circuit to impanel and convene a grand jury in each of the respective counties in the circuit pursuant to Chapter 905; Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, the scheduling of the grand jury term has been vested in the Chief Judge by section 905.01(3), Florida Statutes, it is hereby


ORDERED:

1. All grand juries existing in the Third Judicial Circuit shall be adjourned and desist effective with the impaneling of new grand juries appointed in compliance with this order. Counties whose impaneling dates begin in March shall impanel a grand jury no later than 30 days from the date of this order for terms that run through September, 2014, unless that grand jury was previously impaneled on or after that county's corresponding March 2014 impaneling date.
2. Pursuant to section 905.01(3), Florida Statutes, there shall be a grand jury impaneled in each county of the Third Judicial Circuit every six months, serving for a term of six months as follows:

Columbia County:	1 st Monday of April 1 st Monday of October
Dixie County:	3 rd Monday of April 3 rd Monday of October
Lafayette County:	2 nd Monday of March 2 nd Monday of September
Hamilton County:	3 rd Monday of March 3 rd Monday of September
Madison County:	4 th Monday of March 4 th Monday of September
Suwannee County:	2 nd Monday of April 2 nd Monday of October
Taylor County:	2 nd Monday of March 2 nd Monday of September

3. If any of the above dates fall on a legal holiday, the grand jury will be impaneled the following business day.
4. The dates of each term shall be listed in the Circuit Court Master Calendar.
5. The Clerks of the Third Judicial Circuit shall issue summonses for a pool of potential grand jurors requiring them to appear before the presiding judge on the designated dates listed above.
6. The State Attorney of the Third Judicial Circuit shall be prepared to proceed in accordance with Florida law at each scheduled impanelment of the grand jury.
