**TRANSFERRING ALL PROBATIONERS FORMERLY ASSIGNED TO SALVATION
ARMY CORRECTIONAL SERVICES TO GATEWAY JUDICIAL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Salvation Army Correctional Services unit that formerly served Columbia County has discontinued service to Columbia County;

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Board of County Commissioners has no objection to Salvation Army Correctional Services discontinuing services to Columbia County;

WHEREAS, Gateway Judicial Services has handled half of the probationary workload for Columbia County for the past 17 years for the Columbia County Judge;

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Judge has the utmost confidence in the ability of Gateway Judicial Services to handle all of the probationary services for Columbia County; and


WHEREAS, the Columbia County Judge previously executed a county-specific administrative order, 2020-2, and this administrative order shall serve to ratify 2020-2.

WHEREAS, by the authority vested in me as the Chief Judge of the Third Judicial Circuit, specifically, Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, and upon the request of the Columbia County Judge;

It is therefore **ORDERED**:

All the defendants that are listed in the attached Caseload Detail Lists for the Salvation Army Correctional Services are transferred to Gateway Judicial Services effective immediately. The four Caseload Detail Lists consist of a six-page list of "in person" probationers; one page of "mail in" probationers; a three-page list of "consecutive" probationers; and a twenty-four-page list of probationers in violation status. All four lists are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
