- Second Degree Felonies:* I have been a member of The Florida Bar for at least two years and am an experienced an active trial practitioner with no fewer than six state and federal jury trials, two of which must have been felony trials.

- First Degree Felonies (including life felony, capital sexual battery and Jimmy Ryce cases):* I have been a member of The Florida Bar for at least four years and am an experienced and active trial practitioner with no fewer than eight state or federal jury trials, five of which must have been felony trials.
